Instructions for Students:

- 1. Students should be regular and sincere in studies and are advised to keep the campus clean and beautiful.
- 2. Writing on furniture, walls, toilet blocks is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Pasting handbills, posters anywhere in the college is not allowed.
- 4. Students are appealed to use college property such as furniture, library books, laboratory equipments, sports equipments extremely carefully without causing any damage.
- 5. Vehicles must be parked at the places fixed for parking. Driving on the playground or other areas is strictly prohibited. College uniform and I-Card is compulsory.

Building for Junior college:

Independent imposing building beautified by garden with spacious classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, library with reading hall, separate waiting hall for girls, advanced computer laboratories with UPS backup facility and internet connection, administrative offices, water coolers, toilets at each floor of building, separate parking for girls and boys.

Hostel Services:

- 1. For admission to boy's and girl's hostel students have to fill up a separate application form.
- 2. If selected for admission to hostel, students have to pay the requisite fees in time.
- 3. Students cannot leave the hostel without warden's prior permission.
- 4. Friends and relatives are not allowed to enter the hostel rooms.
- 5. No outside meals are allowed.
- 6. All other hostel rules must be followed.

Staff:

We have a dynamic, pro-active team of highly studious & experienced teachers periodically supported by visiting teachers.

Scholarships:

All scholarships offered by the central and state Govt. are made available to eligible students.

- 1. All scholarships of the central and the state government are made available to students.
- 2. After admission students have to fill up separate scholarship form with necessary documents and submit it within the time limit.
- 3. Students eligible to receive scholarship will have to open account in the bank notified by the college.
- 4. Students whose scholarship is not sanctioned will have to pay all fees as per rules.
- 5. Late submission of the scholarship forms, and forms without documents may lead to rejection of the scholarship form.

Library:

Well-equipped library with large number of text books, reference books, highest number of National & International Journals & periodicals, e-book, e-journals & CDs, photocopying facility, Internet Facility, independent reading hall for girl student. Braille machine for visually impair students.

- 1. For all library transaction, the identity card is compulsory.
- 2. Obtaining identity card after admission is must.
- 3. Students who fail to obtain Identity Card within the time given will be charged late fees of Rs. 50/- in the first term and Rs. 100/- in the second term.

- 4. Students must collect library card by producing Identity card. The library ticket duly filled pasting one photograph, is to be submitted at the issue counter for borrowing books for home reading.
- 5. If library reader's ticket is lost, student has to inform the librarian in writing, towards replacement cost. Students will have to pay Rs. 50/- for the library reader's ticket.
- 6. For home reading & self study books are issued for seven days against library reader's ticket.
- 7. Students who fail to return books before the due date will have to pay late fees of Rs. 1per day, per book.
- 8. While borrowing, students must check the books thoroughly irrespective of damage, missing pages, etc
- 9. Students returning books with missing pages or damaged form will have to replace the book or pay its price as per rules.
- 10. Students should submit an application form for availing book bank facility.

I.T. /Computer Centre

Well-equipped computer laboratory with 30 computers, server, scanner, printer with 24 hours internet facility. Many students have been getting benefit of this laboratory every year.

Incentives

Special awards for freeship and half freeship to meritorious students, outstanding sport players and physically disabled students.

Sports Facilities

Sports department offers all facilities for indoor and outdoor games. In the college, valuable guidance is given for various games and sports such as Cricket, Basket ball, Volley ball, Kabbadi, Athletics, Yogas, Soft ball, Kho-Kho, Table tennis, Judo, Wrestling, Badminton, Weight Lifting, Lawn-Tennis, Chess etc. For these games well decorated and sufficient play ground is available.

Eligibility for admission to Junior College:

- 1. S.S.C. passed from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education from any division.
- 2. Students passing S.S.C. from other states will have to obtain eligibility certificate of Aurangabad Divisional Board and submit the migration certificate within time.
- 3. Students desirous to seek admission to XI Science should have secured minimum 40 percent marks in science subjects.
- 4. Students seeking admission to subjects on non-grant basis will have to pay additional fees.
- 5. Admissions are available as per the government rules based on merit and reservation.
- 6. Some admissions are available on non-grant basis.

Students should submit following documents in original along with three photo copies of each.

- 1. School Leaving Certificate + 3Xerox
- 2. S.S.C. Marks Memo (Xerox) 3 copies
- 3. Eligibility Certificate (If applicable)
- 4. Caste Certificate (If applicable)
- 5. Income Certificate (If the guardian's annual income is less than Rs.1,00,000/-)
- 6. E.B.C. forms in duplicate
- 7. The application form should be accompanied by three passport size photographs.
- 8. Adhar Card. (Student + Parents) (Father + Mother) 3 Copies

GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

- 1. In Special Test program, The answer paper meticulously assessed by the expert experienced teachers and given to students as per schedule. Minimum fees will be charged for this test program. Parents are expected to observe their ward's answer papers personally and give their feedback to the college.
- 2. Parents should enquire about regularity of their ward & visit to college at least twice in a month.
- 3. Parents are expected to make themselves available for parents meeting.
- 4. For all-round-development of the student, parents should promote them to participate in co-curricular activities of the college.

Note:

- 1. Students desire to optional subject Electronics, Computer Science should submit separate prescribed application. Selection on merit basis and as per constitutional reservation norms
- 2. Attendance for Theory and Practical is compulsory.
- 3. Student who obtained subject electronics, Computer science will be exempted from biology and second language.
- 4. Seats are limited for Electronics and Computer Science.
- 5. 30 seats for computer science & 30 seats for electronics

SIGNIFICANT INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

A) Admission:

- All admissions are computerized.
 Students have to remember and use the PRN- permanent registration number.
- 2) Students should have sufficient number of true copies of the original documents before they submit original documents to college.
- 3) Necessary documents like eligibility certificate, migration certificate, E.B.C forms must be submitted within the time.
- 4) All admissions are provisional and on verification, the Principal reserves the rights of final admission and can cancel any admission at any time.
- 5) Students must preserve all college receipts without which any fee will not be refunded.
- 6) Students have to collect Science Journals for all subject immediately after admission from library.

B)Attendance:

- 1) As per new evaluation pattern implemented in state board 75% attendance for theory classes and practicals are compulsory.
- 2) Continuous absence for classes will be liable for action.
- 3) Attendance for college tests, tutorials and terminal examinations is compulsory else marks will be not given.
- 4) Performance of Students throughout the year will be monitored and reported to parents.
- 5) Use of unfair means in the college and board examinations is strictly prohibited.

C) Discipline and Good Conduct:

- 1) Rude and arrogant behavior with any college employee will meet with disciplinary action.
- 2) Ragging, teasing, abusing, torturing or causing physical or mental injury to others will invite legal action as per the Govt. Law.
- 3) Use of mobile phones in the classrooms, corridors, offices, reading halls and examination halls is strictly prohibited. During all the college functions the mobile phone must be switched off. Violation of this instruction will lead to confiscation of the handsets.
- 4) Student found guilty of immoral behavior will be immediately restricted.
- 5) Deliberate attempts to disturb teaching, learning and college functioning will attract disciplinary action.

- 6) Students must bear the Identity Card in the college. They must not invite any friends or relatives to the college campus during the working hours of the college.
- 7) The college uniform is compulsory.

D) Punitive action as per statue Section 87 (8) and Ordinance 129:

- 1) Imposition of fine up to Rs. 300/- or more.
- 2) Preventing from attending the classes for specified period.
- 3) Disqualifying from participating in any co-curricular or cultural activities of the college.
- 4) Withholding of any college document.
- 5) Denial of admission to a course to College/University or Board Examination.
- 6) Cancellation of admission to the college at any stage.
- 7) With holding of examination results.
